**AVOIDING THE BAGGAGE BLUES**

Baggage allowances and baggage sizes on international flights vary according to the airline, class of service and routing in place on your itinerary — and they may change at short notice. Check with your airline for the most current regulations. Charges for overweight baggage may be substantial and are solely the responsibility of the traveler.

Travelers should plan to travel with one suitcase and one carry-on bag that will fit in motor coach overhead bins or under the seat in front of you.

New rules require your checked luggage to be left unlocked. Make a listing of what is in your bag.

If your checked luggage is delayed, will you have what you need to see you through? Pack essential supplies such as medication, toiletries, etc. in your carry-on bag.

All checked baggage should be tagged with the "bright pink" Passport To Travel tags provided. Place contact information inside your bag as well as outside.

**AIRLINE TICKETS**

Due to schedule changes, check your itinerary carefully.  
**Do follow** the times/flight numbers on your itinerary.

A 2 1/2 hour to 3 hour check-in is required for international travel. Upon check-in at the airport, confirm that your frequent flyer number is entered into your reservation. (Frequent flyer numbers disappear during schedule changes.) If it is not entered, provide the number to the airline.

Keep your boarding passes and passenger receipt until you receive your statement crediting the miles to your account.

We will request your desired seat assignments, but cannot guarantee them.
