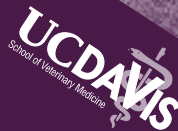

Courses are limited to 24 participants, so register early!

Beginning/Review Course teaches knowledge and skills necessary to perform a complete abdominal ultrasound exam with an emphasis on normal organs.

Provides morning lectures and afternoon laboratories. Reviews how ultrasound images are created so participants can use equipment to attain the necessary image, setting-up the equipment and understanding the controls to accomplish the needed study. Reviews normal and abnormal abdominal organ images, and frames a method to perform a consistent examination. The afternoon laboratories provide participants with hands-on ultrasound exam experiences on live dogs with one instructor per three students. Participants will return to their practices with new abilities to create and interpret the necessary images to evaluate the abdomen.

Intermediate Course emphasizes the pathology of abdominal disease as “seen by the eyes of ultrasound”.

Lectures will cover diseases of the major abdominal organs, and the techniques utilized to find the smaller organs such as the adrenal and the pancreas. The curriculum uses case studies to help participants understand the image within the patient’s presenting signs. A lecture module will cover biopsy techniques of the major organs.

The three-hour laboratories each afternoon include hands-on scanning of dogs with one instructor per three students, and will include a biopsy component using phantoms. Participants will advance their skills in creating and interpreting images, and receive CD-Rom’s with an extensive library of abnormal images to help continue strengthening interpretation skills.
