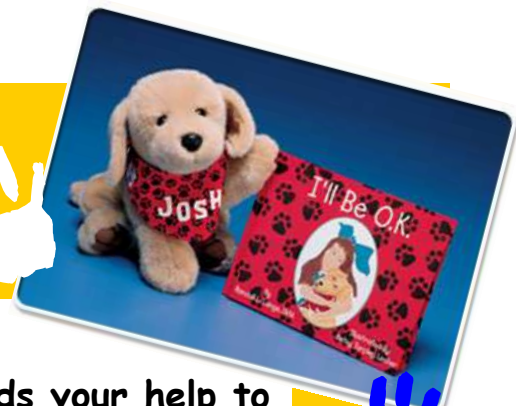


Join us in helping Josh
