Bartlett Honorary address after being selected for the award for his research in equine reproduction and contraception in wildlife. Dr. Liu performed extensive research on zona pellucida immunocontraception. He received a standing ovation during his address given at the Therio Annual Convention in Monterey, California August 7-11. During an awards dinner also held at the convention, Dr. Liu received a check for \$1,000 and a Nandi statue with wooden base and engraved panels.
