

**Working Agreement under the Agreement of Cooperation
Between
College of Veterinary Medicine
National Chung Hsing University
and
The School of Veterinary Medicine
University of California, Davis**

In conforming with the declarations and clauses in the Agreement of Cooperation between College of Veterinary Medicine, National Chung Hsing University (NCHU) and the School of Veterinary Medicine, University of California, Davis (UCD) and to promote and facilitate exchange and cooperation between the two institutions within specialty areas of veterinary medicine, the following Working Agreement for an exchange program in veterinary medicine has been developed to be executed as an amendment to the said Agreement.

Under this amendment the institutions involved will collaborate through:

- Exchange of investigative programs related to animal health
- Training in small animal clinical case studies
- Exchange of technical and professional expertise in the area of pet animals and poultry
- Veterinary student training programs
- Interchange of publication and audiovisual materials
- Interchange of professors and investigators on specialty areas of interest in veterinary medicine
- Development of collaborative research programs

Under the terms of this agreement the institutions involved will:

- Exchange researchers, including veterinary students and other affiliated personnel for at least a period of one academic year or other suitable period. The designated time period for each faculty, veterinary student and resident exchange will be for no longer than 2-4 weeks.
- For the Veterinary Medical Teaching Hospital, there will be no more than a total of two (2) veterinary exchange students or residents per year for which visiting fees will be waived for up to 4 weeks. The students visiting UCD must have good usage of the English language and good communication skills. Students visiting UCD may or may not be accepted into their first choice rotations, depending on available space, and will not be given primary case responsibilities.
- Each institution will continue the salary of its own employee(s) while he or she is participating in the exchange (i.e., the Taiwanese participants at UCD will continue to receive their salary from the NCHU and American participants will similarly be paid by UCD while working in Taiwan.) The cost relating to tuition

fees from the visiting exchange participants will be determined on a case-by-case basis. Accommodations for lodging will be determined 6 months prior to the arrival of participants to the institution. Travel costs will be the responsibility of the participant's home institution.

- In the exchange of students, neither institution will be expected to take any action which would be contrary to its established regulations and practice.
- Each institution involved will name a Program Coordinator for this exchange.
- This agreement, which becomes effective upon its signature by all parties involved, shall continue in force as stated except as it is revised by mutual consent of all parties involved.

It may be terminated by either party upon giving six months written notice to the other parties.




